

Marcelo C. Borba is a professor of the graduate program in Mathematics education and of the mathematics department of UNESP (State University of Sao Paulo), campus of Rio Claro, Brazil. He currently serves at an important Education committee in the main research funding agency of Brazil. He researches the intersection of information and communication technology and mathematics education since 1988, when he started studying at Cornell University, USA.

He is a member of the editorial board of *Educational Studies in Mathematics* and *ZDM*, and a consultant for several journals and funding agencies both in Brazil and abroad. He is the author of *Humans-with-media and reorganization of mathematical thinking* published by Springer in 2005.

He gave invited talks in countries such as Canada, Denmark, Mozambique, Mexico, New Zealand, Italy and United States. He has been a member of the program committee of several international conferences. He wrote several books, book chapters and papers published in Portuguese and in English, and he is the editor of a collection of books in Brazil, which includes eighteen books to date.
